Superintendent Report

Student Count: Mr. Perkins included a count sheet of the number of students in each class attending both Glasco and Miltonvale Schools. Glasco has 88 K-12 students and Miltonvale has 87 K-12 students for a total enrollment of 169.5. District total is down 2 ½ kids from last year. Male/Female ratio about 50/50.

Transportation:

Mr. Perkins included a sheet with the vehicle mileage for the 2020/2021 school year. 96,934 total miles and 8,435 gallons of fuel used. Report for drivers, mileage and fuel gets turned into the state every year to receive reimbursement for sped.

Mr. Perkins told the Board about a presentation for 6-12 (Mitlonvale and Glasco), "Think Before You Post" that will be held September 30,2021.
